Skipton International's Online Mortgage Portal Setting up Two Factor Authentication

Step 1 - Setup Two Factor Authentication

The link in the email will take you to a new web-page where you will be asked to set up your two factor authentication (2FA). To complete this step you will need to have a 2FA app downloaded onto your device e.g Duo, Microsoft Authenticator, Google Authenticator, etc.

Skipton International's Online Mortgage Portal uses two layers of security – 2FA and a password.


Firstly you need to set up your 2FA. Using your authenticator app on your device, scan the QR code on screen and enter the six digit code from the app into the box below the QR code.

If you are unable to scan the QR code, enter the secret key displayed on screen into your authenticator app and then enter the six digit code into the box below the QR code. Click 'Next'

Download an authenticator app on your mobile device. Scan the QR code, then enter the One-Time-Passcode from your device into the box below. If you require guidance, please see our [User Guides](#).

If you are unable to scan the above QR code, select the option in your app to manually enter the Secret Key and provide the following Key when requested:

BPPYFOV7UUE/TJBRYSDU3X4RDI/AKZML3

Then enter the code provided by your authenticator app into the "One-Time-Passcode" box above.

Step 2 - Create password

You will then be asked to set a password. Please ensure this password is at least 8 characters long and includes an uppercase letter, a lowercase letter and at least 1 number. Enter the password twice and click Set Password. You will automatically be logged into the portal.

Next time you log into the portal, you will be required to enter in the six digit code from your authenticator app and your password.
